





### **“The Clinical Diagnosis of Extra-Dental Sources of Facial Pain”**

**By Teo Forcht Dagi MD, DMedSc, DHC, MBA, MPH, FRCSEd, FAANS, FACS, FCCM**



Dr. Teo Forcht Dagi is a neurosurgeon with long-term interests in atypical facial pain. After medical school at Johns Hopkins and training at the MGH, he served as a flight surgeon and combat neurosurgeon in the US Army Medical Corps. Subsequently, he focused on trauma, base-of-skull, pituitary, and stereotactic radio-surgery. For the past 10 years, he has served as the chairman of faculty of medicine of Queen’s University Belfast, where he was appointed Distinguished Scholar and Professor, and principal advisor to the office of the Vice Chancellor of the University.

Teo is a director of the Anesthesia Patient Safety Foundation and an overseer of the Beth Israel Deaconess Medical Center. He is a past chair of the Committee on Perioperative Care of the American College of Surgeons, the Council on Surgical and Perioperative Safety. He also served, and has been reappointed Director of the American Association of Neurological Surgeons. He has published several books and over 150 articles. Among other awards and decorations, Teo was conferred the US Humanitarian Service Medal and Fellowship in the College of Critical Care Medicine. He is a Dixon Medalist, and was granted Fellowship ad hominem by the Royal College of Surgeons of Edinburgh.

Teo lives in Newton and is married to Linda Dagi, a pediatric ophthalmologist at Boston Children. They have three children. He is a pianist, photographer and amateur historian of science.
