### Endo-Ortho Interactions: Treatment Choices and Outcomes



**James Gutmann, DDS** is a diplomate of the American Board of Endodontics and a professor emeritus in endodontics/restorative sciences at Texas A&M University Baylor College of Dentistry in Dallas, TX.

Interactions between endodontics and orthodontics have not been clearly defined, in particular when making treatment planning decisions relative to nonsurgical and surgical choices. Interactions may be as simple as the inflammation that may occur during tooth movement and its perception as pulpal or periapical pain; or inflammation that may occur around teeth that are being moved; or a full range of pulpal inflammation, tooth resorption, and interrelated treatment such as tooth extrusion following trauma. The full range of potential and real interactions will be addressed.
